

WHAT TO BRING

An application must be submitted personally and with all the required documents listed in the application form and below mentioned specific documentation. The application forms shall either be typed or filled in with block letters.

Family reunification:

- Two application forms (1 original + 1 copy)
- Proof of the fee, deposited with the Danish Immigration Service.
- Six passport size photographs. The photographs must be size 3.5 x 4.5 cm, facing and looking directly into the camera, light and neutral background. Head must measure 3.0-3.6 cm from chin to top of the head, and the upper part of the shoulder should be visible. No more than six months old and a good likeness of you, bareheaded unless you have special religious reasons, no sunglasses
- Birth Certificate along with English Translation, attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs – original and colour photocopy
- Marriage Certificate (if married) along with English Translation attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs – original and colour photocopy
- Family Registration Certificate (B-form) ¹⁾ of applicants' parents, brothers and sisters, along with English Translation, attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs – original and colour photocopy
- Divorce decree or death certificate along with English Translation, if you or your spouse have been previously married, attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs – original and colour photocopy
- Colour photocopy of applicant's passport (+ previous passport if any)

Applicants are kindly asked to attach the enclosures in serials according to above mentioned list.

- 1) Afghan nationals should bring their Tazkra attested by the Afghan Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the Afghan Embassy or Consulate in Pakistan.
- 2) Nikkah Khat (marriage certificate) attested by the Afghan Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the Afghan Embassy or Consulate in Pakistan.

Education

- Two application forms (1 original and 1 copy)

- Six passport size photographs. The photographs must be size 3.5 x 4.5 cm, facing and looking directly into the camera, light and neutral background. Head must measure 3.0-3.6 cm from chin to top of the head, and the upper part of the shoulder should be visible. No more than six months old and a good likeness of you, bareheaded unless you have special religious reasons, no sunglasses
- Birth Certificate attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs – original and colour photocopy
- Birth Certificate translated into English and attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs – original and colour photocopy
- Marriage Certificate (if married) attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs – original and colour photocopy
- Marriage Certificate (if married) translated into English and attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs – original and colour photocopy
- Family Registration Certificate (B-form) ¹⁾ of applicants' parents, brothers and sisters, attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs – original and colour photocopy
- Family Registration Certificate (B-form) ¹⁾ of applicants' parents, brothers and sisters, translated into English and attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs – original and colour photocopy
- Documentation for being enrolled in an educational institution in Denmark and documentation for payment of fee, if any
- Documentation of studies in Pakistan in the form of degree certificates, attested by the Higher Education Commission and The Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Islamabad – original and colour photocopies.
- Proof of the fee, deposited with the Danish Immigration Service.

Applicants must document that they have in their own name the necessary financial means to support themselves for the duration of stay in Denmark, or instead when applicable must document that they have paid fee for the first semester or year.

Applicants are kindly asked to attach the enclosures in serials according to above mentioned list

- 1) Afghan nationals should bring their Tazkra form attested by the Afghan Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the Afghan Embassy or Consulate in Pakistan.
- 2) Nikkah Khal (marriage certificate) attested by the Afghan Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the Afghan Embassy or Consulate in Pakistan.
